**PSPC Ships 160 M Memory Devices in Q3**

Clark Freeport, Pampanga. Phoenix Semiconductor Philippines Corp (PSPC) announced that its shipments of memory devices in the third quarter totaled 160 million units, slightly exceeding expectations during the period.

The production shipment to its exclusive customer Samsung Electronics of South Korea is worth the export value of US\$ 452 million for the third quarter. This is higher by 62% from the US\$ 279 million registered in the second quarter.

In line with PSPC's migration of memory chip production to the next-generation DDR4 technology, the Company produced and shipped 57 million 8 and 4-gigabyte dynamic random access modules (DRAM) and flip-chip memory chips in the third quarter of 2016. It

continued to assemble DDR3 DRAM devices at 88 million units, while producing 15 million branded memory cards during the same period.

"We aim to increase production of the DDR4 memory chips in the fourth quarter, while fulfilling remaining orders of DDR3 technology to serve the final customers of Samsung," said PSPC President Byeongchun Lee.

He explained that many branded PC and laptop assemblers still produce older versions of the motherboards to use up existing inventories. The weak global economy, he added, has constrained branded computing device makers to slow down production and roll-out of new laptop and PC models utilizing the next-gen memory technology in the market.


The Company likewise announced that production orders have been forecast at 210 million units of memory devices in the fourth quarter of 2016, a jump of 31% from the 160 million units recorded in the third quarter. Production of the DDR4 chips is set to rise 62% to 78 million units from the previous quarter's 57 million units.

Mr. Lee pointed out that the cautious outlook in global consumer demand for electronics and computing devices arising from the soft economies of China and countries in Europe has dampened what otherwise would be higher production levels of memory and other semiconductors. The US election has also resulted in uncertainties in the real economy and financial markets around the world.
