### Press Release:

SSP Posts Net Income of US\$8.45 M

in First Nine Months of 2020

Publicly listed SFA Semicon Philippines Corporation (Trading Symbol: SSP) announced that its net income after tax almost tripled to US\$8.45 million in the first three quarters this year from US\$2.86 million it registered in the same period in 2019. On a per share basis, its earnings totaled US\$0.0039 this year compared to US\$0.0013 last year.

The Clark Freeport-based memory semiconductor outsourced assembly and test provider recorded gross revenues of US\$251.60 million in 2020, up 8% from the U\$231.96 million in the same period last 2019. Last year, SSP delivered breakthrough financial results as it reported hefty improvements in its revenues and net income despite the industry downturn in 2019.

SEC Form 17-C December 2003 "Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, the Company is continuing the momentum we set last 2019 and we are responding to the uncertainties and challenges during the year," SSP Chairman and President Joonsang Kang said.

Mr. Kang explained that SSP has been able to take advantage of the recovery in the PC and mobile memory markets which has been benefited by strong demand for consumer products that address communications and business needs during the extended periods of lockdowns around the world.

He added that the strong top-line financial performance was driven by the continued uptick in sales volumes as over-all production output rose 14% to 775 million memory units in the first three quarter of the year from the 678 million units last year.

Production output of DRAM memory modules increased 5% year-on-year from 634 million units last 2019 to 667 million units in 2020. Component chips assembled and tested surged to 99 million units in the first nine months of 2020 from 30 million units view of strong orders from its main customer.

Memory modules are devices consisting of chips mounted on printed circuit board assemblies and are used in laptops, PC desktop units and servers which experienced resurgent demand this year.

SSP has been driven by its global marketing strategy and by continuing cost-efficiency measures across its manufacturing operations. Its operating income multiplied nearly three times from US\$3.97 million in 2019 to US\$ 11.17 million during the period under review in 2020. Increased manufacturing efficiencies and lower administrative expenses mitigated the impact of lower average selling prices of memory products during the year.

Mr. Kang said that positive outlook remains for the Company in view of the re-opening of many countries around the world from the global lockdown, including China, and the resurgent US economy. Shipments of semiconductors, notably the memory sector, have been on the uptrend despite initial expectations of weakness due to the pandemic crisis.

SSP plans to continue with its strategies and plans this year to improve its performance as a preferred semiconductor assembly and test provider in the global semiconductor industry.
