The total amount of shares repurchased includes incidental costs such as broker's commission, VAT, and other PSE-mandated

As a result of the share buyback made on January 5, 2024, the remaining amount (from the total amount appropriated for the share buyback program of SSP), as of this date, is ₱13,832,664.40.
